Peru. — *Madrid Filatelico* states that new stamps of the values of 1, 2, and 5 c. have appeared, but, the *American Journal of Philately* asserts, this is certainly an error, as it has received information from Lima that their issue is to be delayed until the opening of the new Post Office. From this the *A. J. P.* infers that the issue is to be a speculative one, particularly as a new stamp of the value of 5 centavos, of the current type but printed in green, has just been received.

Messrs. Williams & Co. inform us that the 5 and 10 c. Unpaid Letter Stamps have now been surcharged "Déficit," and send us at the same time a sample of the new provisional postal card made by surcharging the 5 c. card for use as a 2 c. The surcharge is exactly like that on the card issued in 1893, except that the figure "2" in the left-hand upper corner is solid instead of open-faced.

Philippines. — *Le Timbre-Poste* chronicles a series of provisionals made by surcharging certain values of the 1890 type with head of baby king. The surcharge, in a rectangular frame, consists of the figure of value with the word "CENTS" below, surrounded by the inscription, above "CORREOS," below "1897," on the left "HABILITADOS," and on the right "PARA."
