The exploits have been done by members who hold posts in the directorship of the society. (The letter was published as "Notes from Madrid" in [Stanley Gibbons Monthly Journal, 1899a](#)). The author is identified in [Stanley Gibbons Monthly Journal \(1900a\)](#) as Mr Charles H. Younger of Madrid.

## Yvert & Tellier. (catalogue)

Louis Yvert and Theodule Tellier published their first worldwide catalogue of postage stamps in November 1896 in Amiens, France. Their success was in part due to their logical and permanent numbering, in contrast to most of their contemporaries, who changed the numbers in their catalogues upon discovering forgotten stamps.

In 1900, Yvert et Tellier associated with Paris stamp dealer Théodore Champion, who sold unused stamps from all over the world. He fixed the prices of the stamps sold by the company. In April 1913, Tellier sold his share of the company to Louis Yvert. Due to their friendship, Yvert decided that the catalogue would continue to be named Yvert et Tellier. During the 1920s and 1930s, Yvert prepared his two sons and his son-in-law to run the firm (Henri and Pierre Yvert and Jean Gervais. After Champion's death in 1955, Pierre Yvert and the brothers Ladislav and Alexandre Varga bought Champion's company, and the new firm continued to fix Yvert et Tellier's prices. Pierre Yvert's and Jean Gervais' two grandsons have run the company since the 1990s.
