##### Abra Philatelic Chronicle.

The **Abra Philatelic Chronicle** magazine was published occasionally in 1935. Constante Batoon was the editor.

The **Airmail Digest** was published quarterly between 1938 and 1940 and was the official publication of the Philippine Air Mail Society and was edited by Pablo Esperidion. The **Airmail Digest Yearbook** was also published in 1940

The magazine folded after a short duration.

#### Mayon Stamp Digest.

The **Mayon Stamp Digest** was published between 1938 and 1941 and was the official journal of the Philippine Philatelic Club, Manila; edited by Pat Yapsinco.

#### Philatelic Ticker.

The **Philatelic Ticker** magazine was a monthly magazine with three issues published in 1944. The magazine was the newsletter of the Philippine Philatelic Club. It was a sister magazine to the **PPC Flashes**. The editor was Severino Luna. The magazine halted upon the arrival in Leyte of the US Armed Forces. The magazine was superseded by the **PPC News**.

### The Postage Stamps Digest

The **Postage Stamps Digest** was a quarterly magazine published Pampanga Stamp Collectors' Society. The Pampanga Stamp Collectors' Society ceased in mid-2000s and was relaunched as a facebook group and renamed the Philippine Stamp Collectors Club in September 2020.

### Philippines Philatelic Bulletin.

The **Philippines Philatelic Bulletin** was published between November 1926 and December 1939 and was the official journal of the National Philatelic Club, Bacolod; edited by Jose Marco in Iloilo, Iloilo. The magazine was published quarterly in English and Spanish.

The **Philippine Philatelist** was a monthly magazine published in 1947 and was the official journal of the Philippine Philatelic Club, Manila. Only three issues were published. The editor was Pablo Esperidion.

### PPC Flashes.

The **PPC Flashes** magazine was published between 15 June and 14 October 1944 with seventeen issues during this period. The magazine was the newsletter of the Philippine Philatelic Club. It was a sister magazine to the **Philatelic Ticker**. The editor was Pablo Esperidion.

### PPC News.

The **PPC News** magazine was a monthly magazine first published in September 1945 and was the first philatelic magazine to be published following liberation, although only two issues were published. The magazine was the newsletter of the Philippine Philatelic Club and superseded the the **Philatelic Ticker**. The editor was Pablo Esperidion. The magazine was suspended due to the prohibitive cost of printing and materials.
